

Apartment preview a hit with buyers

WA builder Pindan has officially launched a new display home at its waterfront development Aqueous at Mandurah Quay.

Future residents and other guests joined Pindan and project syndicate Midstyle Nominees for brunch on May 17 to celebrate the opening of the display apartment and to view the over-all progress of the project.

Completion of stage one of the project is due about the middle of this year and stage two is anticipated to be complete in the first quarter of 2010.

Prices for the remaining available apartments range from \$890,000 to just over \$2 million.
