

Tape officially cut for Atwell College opening

STUDENTS have enjoyed plenty of success since Atwell College started one year ago, and the celebrations continued last Friday when Education Minister Liz Constable officially opened the college.

It is the state's first fully inclusive secondary school – for mainstream students, and those with disabilities – supporting students in its Kim Beazley Learning Community. The \$37.6 million school caters for students from Year 7 to 9.

Dr Constable said the education facility was the culmination of the vision of the community and the active support of several stakeholders including the Atwell Community Association.

“The facilities allow a full range of support services to be specifically tailored to the individual needs of students,” she said.

“The college's modern design and facilities enable development of a close community feel with the focus on the central piazza area and a strong arts influence.”
