

Pindan celebrates double win

BELMONT construction company Pindan was recognised twice at the Master Builders Association of WA annual awards night last week.

Pindan claimed the prize for Best Lifestyle Housing for Seniors (over \$1 million) for design of Kingsley's Woodlake Aged Care facility. It is the second year Pindan has won in this category.

Pindan director Andy Peppercorn said the \$14 million aged-care facility was an important community project.

"Building aged care centres such as Woodlake, that offer a high level of care to those in need, can be compared to building a mini hospital; it's a very complex job," he said. "Because it's also a state-of-the-art lifestyle facility, it also involved building a cafe, library, hydrobath and hair salon."

The company also won a Certificate of Excellence in the Best Commercial-Industrial Building category for Parliament Place in West Perth.
