This is a win not only for Midland Brick, but for all of you and your staff who have worked with us to develop the brick recycling initiative into the successful program it has become.


Pindan Construction has been an integral part of this project and I would like to thank you sincerely for the effort and resources you have contributed, and I hope that this award helps to reinforce your commitment to recycling, as it will for us.

With your help, in the 06/07 financial year Midland Brick recycled more than 7500 tonnes of brick and paver waste from off-site alone – this is equivalent to a staggering 2.71 million individual bricks, or approximately 140 average double brick houses. Much of this waste would previously have gone to landfill, but is now being made into new house bricks.

In the coming year we are looking to substantially increase our recycled tonnes and hope that you will continue to help us build this program.
