



PINDAN ACCOUNTING SCHOLARSHIP TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The Pindan Accounting Scholarship will provide a cash payment of \$5000 to assist with costs associated with studying (textbooks, incidental expenses etc).

The Pindan Accounting Scholarship is not transferable to another University.

A successful applicant who fails to re-enrol in future study periods without having applied for and granted leave of absence will forfeit the scholarship.

Course switching and course deferral is not permitted.

Unless exceptional circumstances can be demonstrated, students who withdraw from studies after the census date, or who are terminated from studies, will be required to repay the cash payment awarded for the relevant semester.

RETAINING ELIGIBILITY FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP

To retain eligibility for The Pindan Accounting Scholarship all students must:

- Remain eligible for a Commonwealth Supported place at the University (this means you must be an Australian citizen, holder of an Australian Permanent Humanitarian Visa, Permanent Resident or a New Zealand Citizen) and;
- Unless there are exceptional circumstances:
 - Remain enrolled full time (100 credits per semester) in the fourth year of a Bachelor of Commerce (Accounting) leading to a recognised degree.
 - Maintain a satisfactory standard of academic progress (Course Weighted Average of at least 70.00 and pass all units attempted.

Determination of exceptional circumstances shall be at the discretion of the Manager, Scholarships and Financial Aid Office.

PAYMENT TENURE

The cash component of the scholarship will be paid to the student in two instalments of \$2,500. First semester payment will occur in April and second semester payment will occur after the census date.

ENROLMENT

Where a student intends taking leave of absence during their studies, the student must apply for and seek approval from the Manager, Scholarships and Financial Aid Office to suspend the scholarship for the period of leave. The student must show exceptional circumstance and apply in writing to the Manager, Scholarships and Financial Aid to suspend the scholarship.

Where a student withdraws or is terminated from their course of study, they will become ineligible for continuation of the Scholarship.
