



Terms of Reference:

- **Pindan Accounting Scholarship**
- **Pindan Construction Management Scholarship**

The Pindan Scholarships have been developed between Pindan Ltd and Curtin University of Technology. Pindan is one of Western Australia's leading multi-disciplined property and construction companies who pride themselves on personal and honest attention to detail, delivering the highest quality product to satisfied clients.

Description:

Two scholarships are available for current enrolled Curtin students:

- Pindan Accounting Scholarship for a 2nd year Bachelor of Commerce (Accounting) student. The value of this scholarship is a cash payment of \$5000 per annum for 2 years maximum and provides vacation employment.
