

PINDAN DRAFTING & DESIGN SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANT INFORMATION

The Pindan Building & Construction Scholarship has been developed between Pindan Pty Ltd and Central TAFE and is available to a 2nd year Diploma of Building Design student. The value of this scholarship is a cash payment of \$5000 and provides paid vacation employment. Pindan is one of Western Australia's leading and fastest growing construction and development management companies. Their expertise includes commercial and residential projects, such as multi-storey residential, aged-care facilities and medium density housing developments.

Completed application forms are required to be submitted by the applicant for assessment and students should include all accompanying documentation, either original or certified copies of originals. Applications will be deemed ineligible if the applicant fails to submit all required documentation.

The Pindan Drafting & Design Scholarship will provide a cash payment of \$5000 to assist with costs associated with studying (textbooks, incidental expenses etc). The award of this scholarship does not preclude the recipient from holding others. Pindan Pty Ltd does reserve the right to amend the cash amount of the award if the recipient holds another scholarship. Pindan Pty Ltd also reserves the right to deem applicants ineligible for this scholarship if in receipt of another. Scholarship recipients may not defer their study and scholarship commencement.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Applicants must meet ALL of the following criteria to be considered for the Pindan Drafting & Design Scholarship:

- Be an Australian citizen, holder of an Australian Permanent Humanitarian visa, Permanent Resident visa or a New Zealand citizen;
- Be an enrolled full student, undertaking their 2nd year Diploma of Building Design studies.

AWARD CRITERIA

The Scholarship(s) will be awarded by a Selection Panel using the following criteria:

- Academic Record
- Response to questions in scholarship application form
- Interview by selection committee

REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION

Documentation required for the Pindan Drafting & Design Scholarship is:

- Proof of Citizenship or visa status (Birth Certificate, Passport or Citizenship Certificate)
- Academic results for applicants Diploma of Building & Design course to date
- Nomination or reference from a Central TAFE Academic/previous employer/recognized community representative

Documents must be either original or certificated copies. Only a Justice of the Peace or a Commissioner of Declarations can certify documents. Original documents will be accepted at Student Central for copying – original documents will be returned. No other copies (including faxes) will be accepted.

PAYMENT TENURE

Once the Pindan Drafting & Design Scholarship has been accepted, the scholarship will commence from the first semester of study of the recipients second year.

The cash component of the scholarship will be paid to the student in two instalments of \$2,500 past census date in each applicable semester. Any cash payments will be on a pro-rata basis if the applicant applies to and receives permission to under load due to exceptional circumstances.

Scholarship continuity is subject to meeting a high standard of academic progress. Unless there are exceptional circumstances, a recipient with unsatisfactory progress shall be ineligible to retain a scholarship. Determination of exceptional circumstances shall be at the discretion of the Learning Portfolio Manager, Central TAFE, in consultation with Pindan Pty Ltd.

ENROLMENT

Unless there are exceptional circumstances students must:

- Maintain a full time study load
- Maintain a high standard of academic progress
- Pass all units attempted

Where a student intends taking leave of absence during their studies, the student must apply for and seek approval from the Learning Portfolio Manager, Central TAFE, in consultation with Pindan Pty Ltd to suspend the scholarship for the period of leave.

Where a student withdraws or is terminated from their course of study, they will become ineligible for continuation of the scholarship.

OTHER CONDITIONS

- The Pindan Drafting & Design Scholarship is not transferable to another TAFE campus.
- A recipient who does not re-enrol in future semesters without having applied for leave of absence will forfeit the scholarship.
- A scholarship may not be transferable to another course of study and extensions of the duration of the scholarship will only be given in extenuating circumstances. Students who change their course of study will forfeit the scholarship.
- Where a student withdraws from study prior to the census date, the student will be required to repay the cash payment awarded for that study period.
- Unless exceptional circumstances can be demonstrated, students who withdraw from studies after the census date, or who are terminated from studies, will be required to repay the cash payment awarded for the relevant semester.
